Our Home Ever After program is a tailor-made future care plan for your beloved pet, should something happen to you.


How Home Ever After works

Our Home Ever After Program
Coordinator works with you to
develop a Pet Profile. This covers
everything we need to know about
your pet, including their likes
and dislikes, favourite toys, food,
sleeping habits, medical needs and
everything in between – all those
unique details that only you would
know.

That way, should we ever need to rehome your pet, we can do so using the information provided by the person who knows them best – you!

If something happens to you, this is what we do:

- Your pet is taken into immediate care and checked by an RSPCA veterinarian
- We use the information that you have provided to search for their new home
- 3 Your pet's welfare is monitored by RSPCA for the rest of their life



We mainly focus on dogs, cats and pocket pets. However, other animals will be considered upon request. Unfortunately, we cannot consider exotic pets such as parrots and reptiles due to their special care requirements.

If you have bonded pets, we will do everything we can to ensure they are rehomed together.

How much does it cost to enrol my pets?

We don't ask for payment for this service, but respectfully request that a gift in your Will be made instead.
