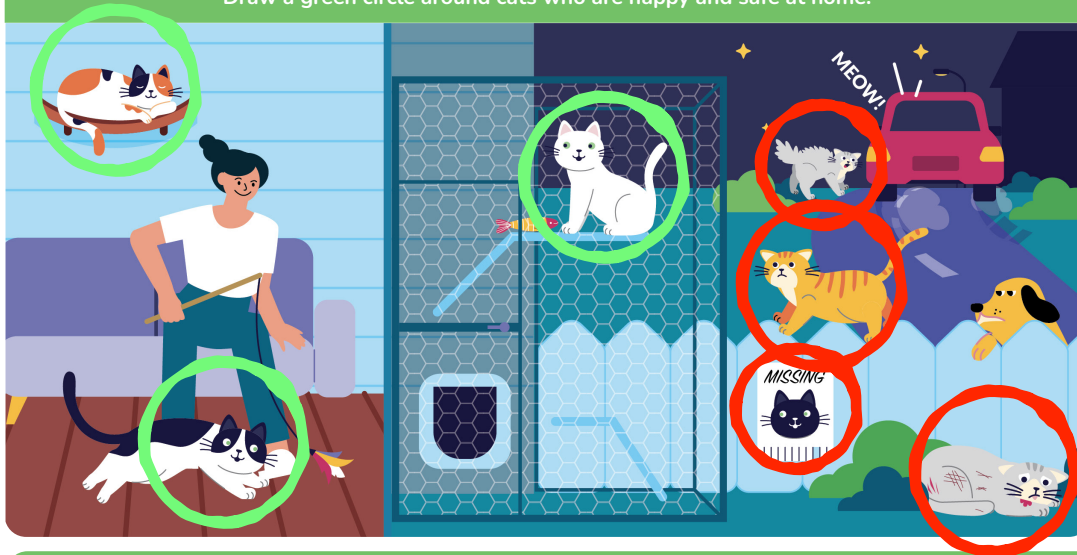




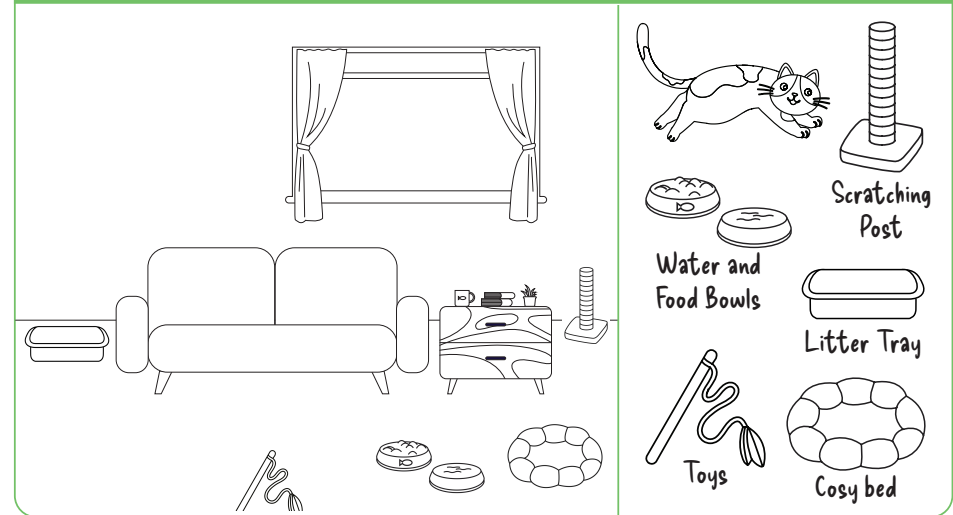
## ACTIVITY 1: FIND-A-CAT

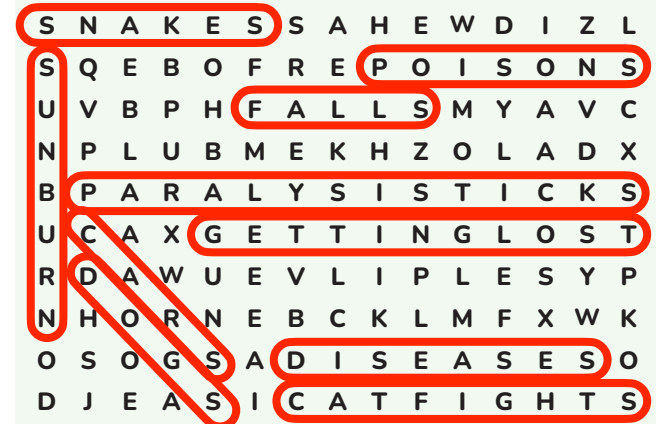
**Frog:** I am an omnivore. I eat fruits and insects. I have a stumpy body, short limbs, and a bright blue tongue.
