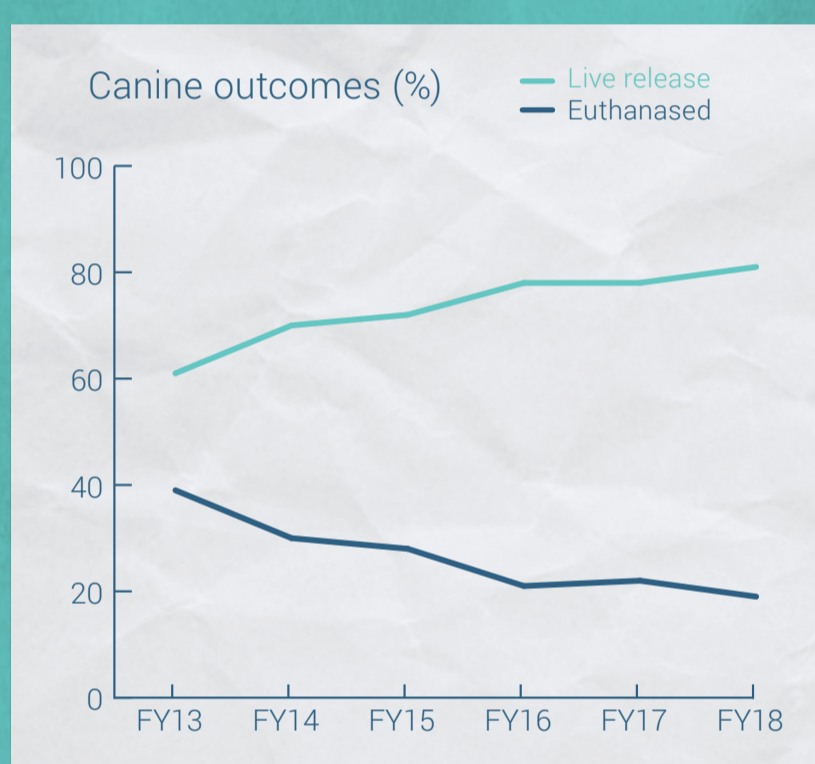

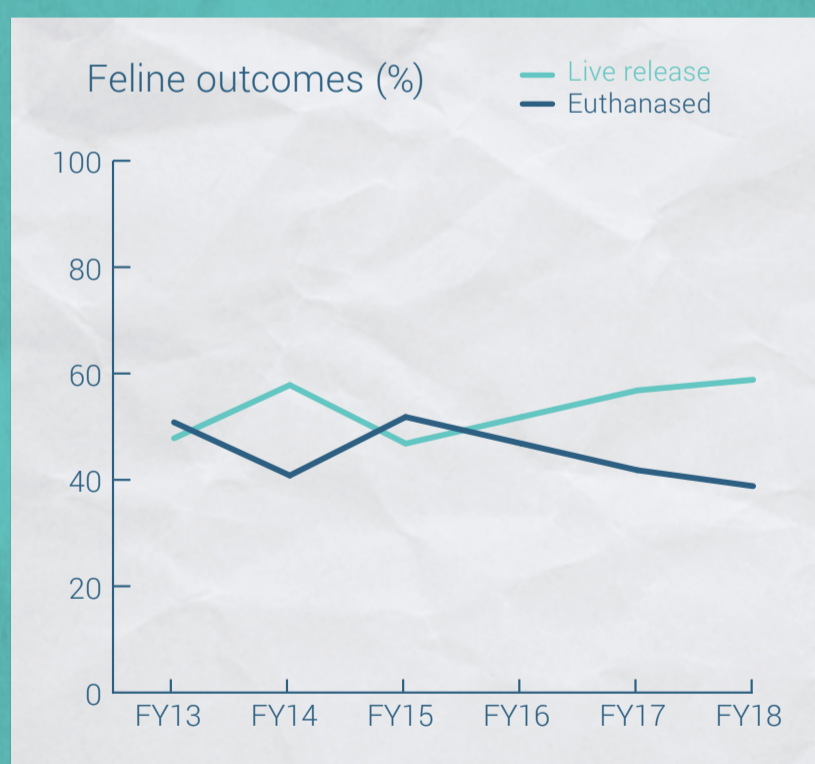

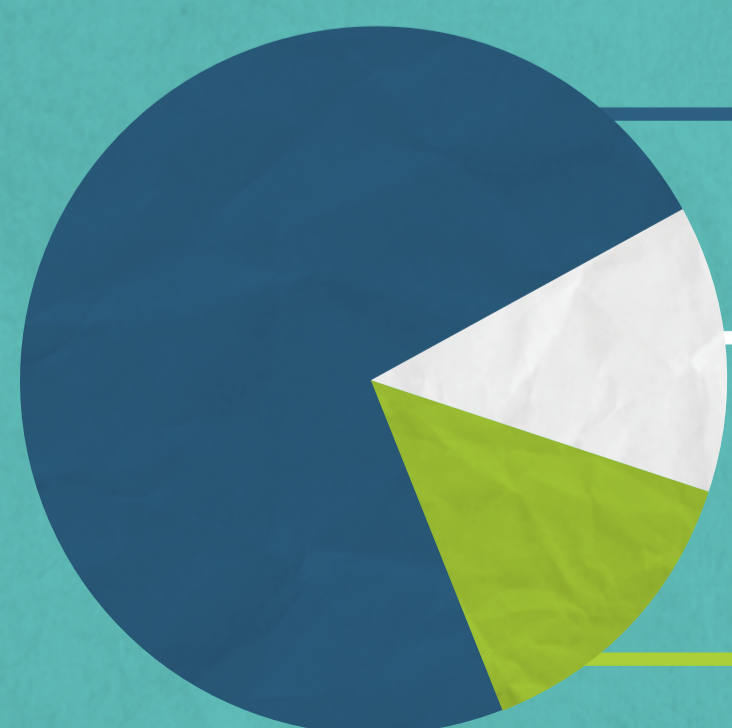

JULY

We had a total of 89 children attend our School Holiday Program, learning how to care for animals and treat them with respect and kindness.

AUGUST

3,375 sweet supporters participated in Cupcake Day for the RSPCA, baking treats for their friends, schoolmates and colleagues and raising much-needed 'dough' for animals in need.

SEPTEMBER

31 amazing animal lovers celebrated national Include a Charity Week by leaving a generous gift to RSPCA NSW in their wills, ensuring that our animals will be cared for beyond their lifetimes.

OCTOBER

542 animals were vaccinated and desexed through our Outreach Program.

NOVEMBER

The RSPCA NSW Illawarra Shelter celebrated its 10th birthday - did you know that since it opened, they have cared for 40,000 animals?



DECEMBER

7,039 supporters became RSPCA Guardian Angels, sharing the Christmas spirit and helping animals in need during the festive season.

JANUARY

We launched our new Graduate Veterinary Training Program, educating the next generation of passionate veterinarians about animal welfare and the other issues faced by our communities.

FEBRUARY

775 animals were rehomed after a three day adoption drive. We cleared over 92% of the animals in our shelters across NSW, finding them new loving forever homes!

MARCH

Our Inspectorate successfully convicted a repeat offender of animal cruelty and an ex-breeder who had been hoarding dogs and puppies in horrific squalor.

APRIL

RSPCA NSW Volunteer Branches invested a total of \$52,288.33 offsetting veterinary costs for people in their communities that were requiring assistance in caring for their pets.



MAY

On Sunday 20 May, 9,299 people all over the state walked to fight animal cruelty and be a voice for the voiceless at our biggest fundraising event of the year, Million Paws Walk.

JUNE

Our generous supporters donated a total of \$611,986.74 to our Winter Warmer Appeal, keeping animals across the state sheltered, warm and cared for during the cold season.
